

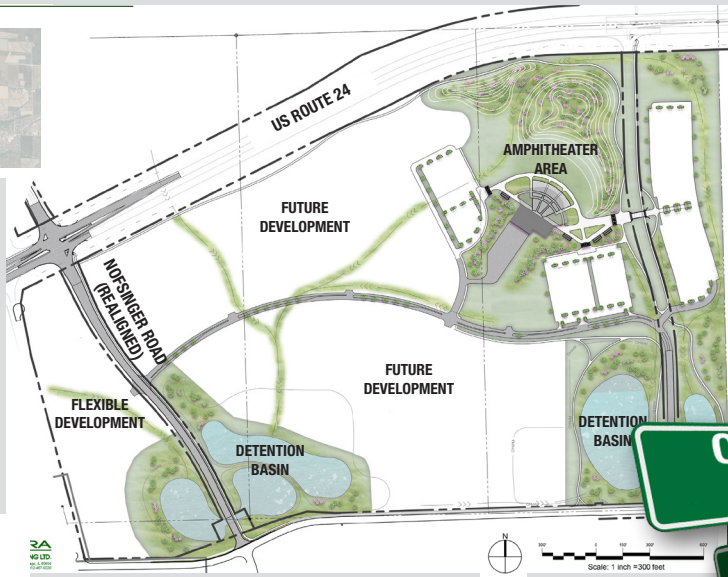

- C** Enhancing educational opportunities of all students through grants and assistance that will promote modernization of classrooms and technologically advanced learning materials;
- D** Working with local and regional partners to assist students realize a path to success in the careers they choose, with special emphasis on young students who face obstacles such as poverty, live in rural communities and race.
- E** Working with local and regional organizations to increase income, improve child nutrition, care for the earth, and ultimately end childhood hunger and poverty, ensuring students have access to a quality education, and providing safe places for all children to play, express themselves and be active in the local and regional area.
- F** Advancing medical research and education through grants and assistance; and
- G** The making of grants, donations, gifts and contributions, exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational purposes that promote the well-being of mankind and shall include any other charitable, religious and educational activities as shall be determined by the Board of Directors to be appropriate.

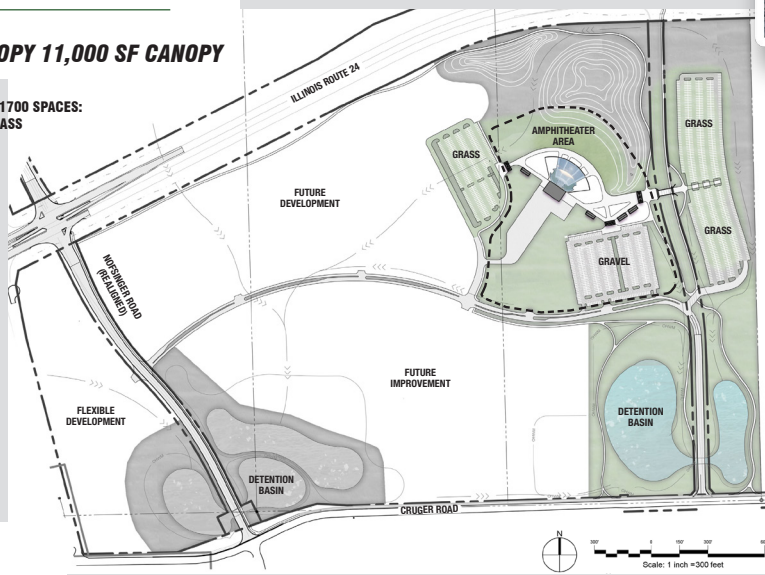
THE DEE CANOPY 11,000 SF CANOPY

Phase one of the comprehensive site plan, as highlighted in the figure to the right, includes the development of an amphitheater venue located near the top right of the site plan.

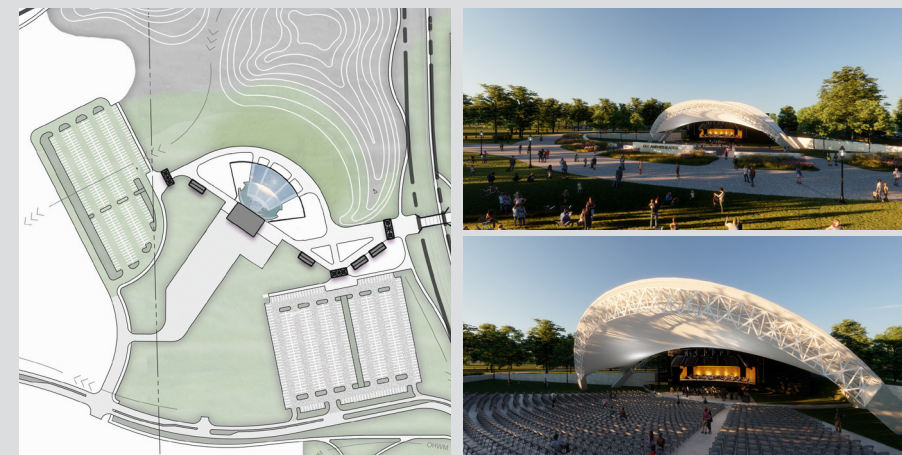
